

The New Zealand Curriculum and Education for Enterprise: Key Actions for Change

Key Actions	What needs to happen in our school
Schools need to explore what they currently do and evaluate if it is meeting the needs of learners.	
Schools need to look at structures and systems currently in place and how they can change/alter these to fit with the needs of students.	
Schools need to adopt a risk taking and flexible approach to curriculum delivery.	
Schools need to provide professional development for staff on E4E pedagogy.	
Schools really need to examine how the enterprising attributes/key competencies currently 'fit' in what they do, how they can 'measure' against them and how students can take ownership of tracking their own personal development.	
Schools need to re-address their vision, purpose and values to see how they align with the new direction in education.	
There needs to be a change in student/ teacher relationships, with students actively making decisions about their own learning.	
School timetables are designed to support learning experiences, not be barriers to them.	
Schools need to focus their curriculum in order to meet the needs of the students in their particular school.
