The Learning Context

Investigate a recreational or sporting facility near you:

- Students visit or contact a recreational or sporting facility in the community or one which they have had some involvement with. They gather information on a series of questions to establish what users the facility caters for, who has access to the facility, costs of attending etc.
- They report this information back to the class via a poster or PowerPoint presentation.

Create the perfect recreational facility for young people in your area or another targeted group.

Once students have identified a target group they brainstorm ideas discuss and plan what a perfect facility might look like. This discussion is recorded and reported back to the class and or local council.

Assessment Ideas

- Student presentation back to the class in form of a poster or speech or a prepared power point.
- A recorded tape message or presentation to class explaining what the facility would look like and whose needs it would cater for and how it would cater for them.
- Use of group and peer assessment.
