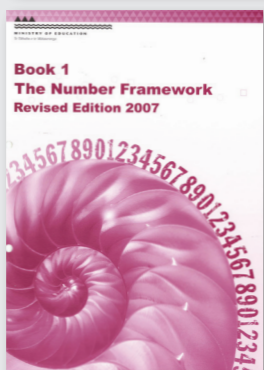
READING AND WRITING STANDARDS

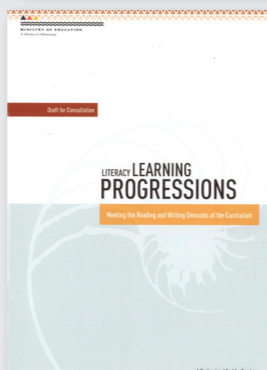
THE NEW ZEALAND CURRICULUM MATHEMATICS STANDARDS FOR YEARS 1-8 WALL CHART

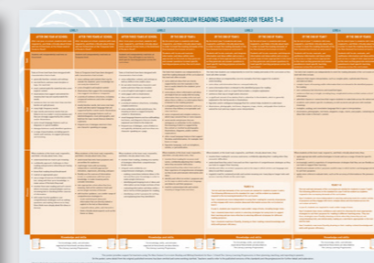
THE NUMBER FRAMEWORK

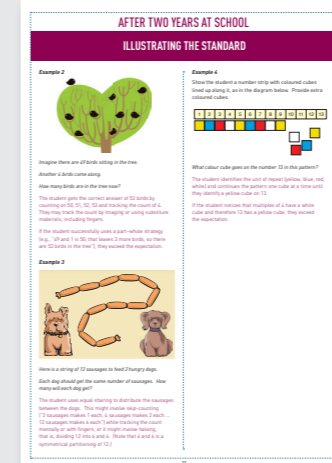
CURRICULUM UPDATES

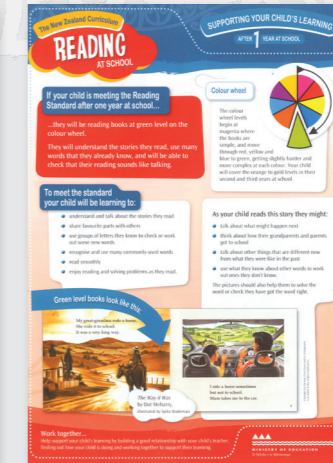
MATHEMATICS ILLUSTRATIONS
