**Re: New Zealand Curriculum Workshops**

The final New Zealand Curriculum document is soon to be available to schools and will be officially launched in early November. The Centre for Educational Development has an important role to play in supporting schools to understand and interpret the document and the change implications for teachers and learners.

As stated in a previous letter, the first phase of the support will be a series of regionally based informational workshops facilitated by Massey University Centre for Educational Development (CED) advisers, local ministry and school leaders. Due to the late launch we are offering workshops in November 2007 and January 2008 for your convenience. Yourself and two representatives may attend the workshop and each workshop will run for a whole day (9am – 4pm) with time in the afternoon for schools to explore next steps.

The second phase, the formation of school clusters, facilitated by sector leaders is well under way with schools being notified within the next week or so. Again, schools not involved in a funded cluster can receive support by advisers, either individually or in clusters, as they do now.
